To CODA's employees, supporters and partners:

Today, April 1st 2026, we are announcing our intention to close our Mental Health Residential Facilities: 8041 and Rolfson House. This will include both residential facilities, all clinical and medical services dedicated to these programs, and the Intensive Case Management services we offer to individuals overseen by the Psychiatric Security Review Board (PSRB). We will spend the next 90 days working with our state, county, and community partners to ensure a safe and smooth transition of the residents in these facilities to other qualified providers.

During this process, we are committed to supporting our employees, our patients, and others in our area who will be impacted.

This decision did not come lightly, nor was it one we made overnight. CODA's core strength is in the provision of treatment for substance use disorders. Rolfson House and 8041 are highly specialized programs, designed to serve individuals with acute, severe, and persistent psychiatric disorders. We have reached a point where the specialization required for these facilities no longer aligns with the expertise at CODA.

To our staff who, in many cases, have dedicated years to these residents and to CODA: we are immeasurably grateful. The individuals who have resided in these facilities are some of our community's most vulnerable. While it feels impossible to convey our appreciation and admiration in a difficult moment like this, we are still incredibly thankful for the time you have been with us.

These closures are specific, and limited to these specialized programs. CODA's substance use disorder continuum remains fully intact. The closure of 8041 and Rolfson House will have no impact on the addictions residential services we provide in Gresham, Tigard, and Beaverton.
